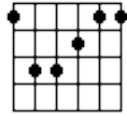


Basic Barre Chords

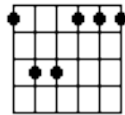
Two categories of barre chords are one that are rooted on the E string or the A string. Remember that the name of the chord is the same as the note fingered on the bottom string. For example, using the E root Major 7th on the 5th fret would be an A7 chord.

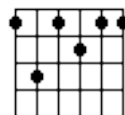
Major (E root)



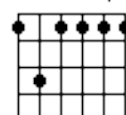
Minor (E)



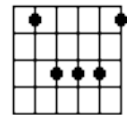
Major 7th (E)



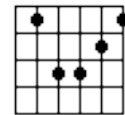
Minor 7th (E)



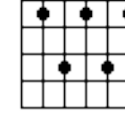
Major (A root)
